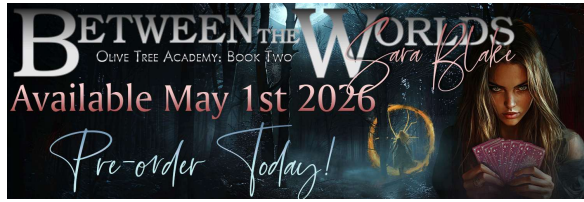

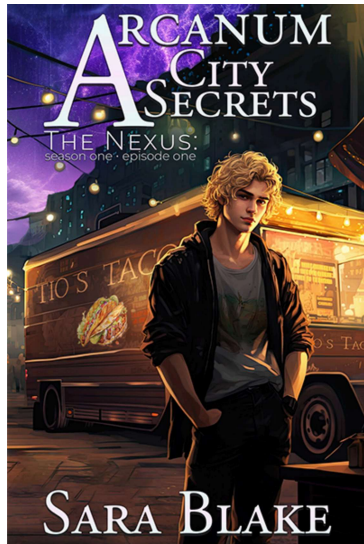

There'll be a link to this page in **EVERY** newsletter from here forward (It's the "newsletter archive" link in the header,) so you can always access your [free books](#) and other special content!

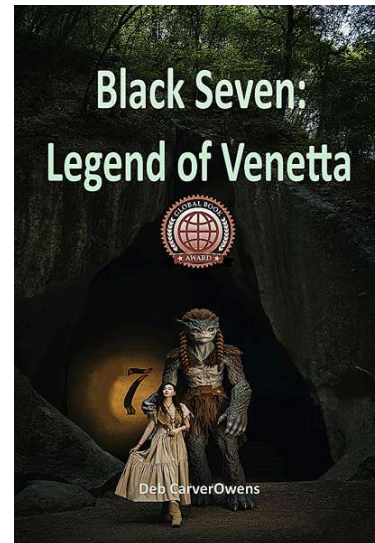

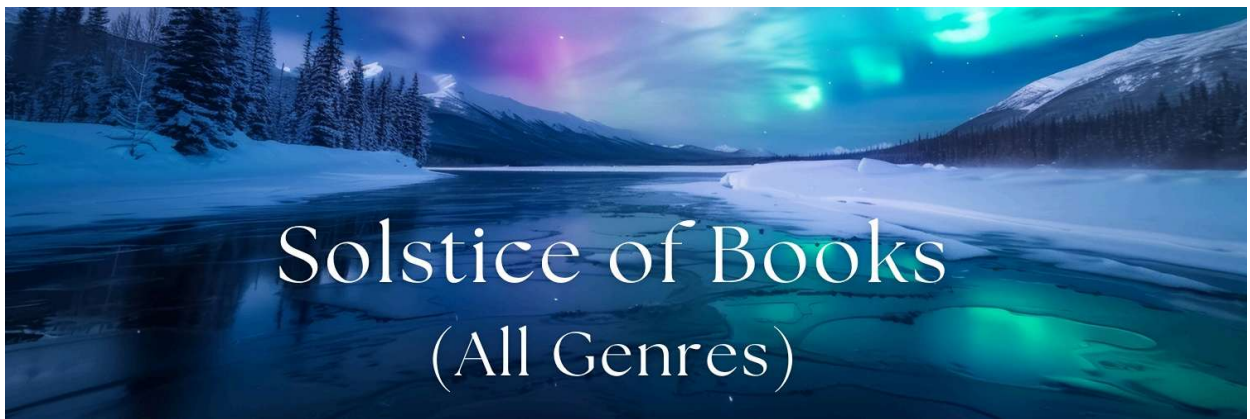

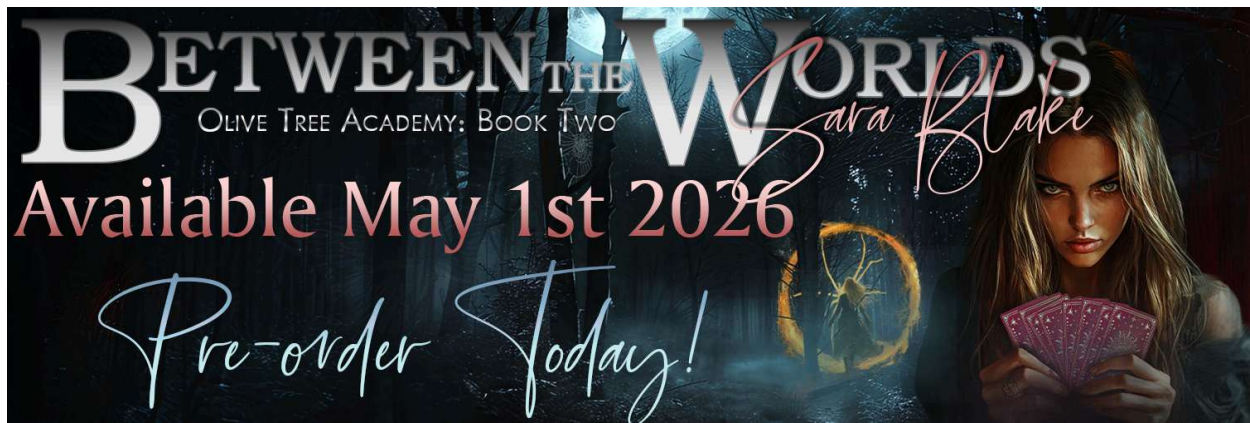
